

Answers to Inspire RFP Questions

Q: Do you have to be a 501(3)(c) organization to apply?

A: No. The RFP is open to municipal agencies, non-profit organizations [501(3)(c)s], as well as private, for profit entities.

Q: Do you need to apply to serve the entire age range specified in the RFP?

A: No. You can apply to serve the entire age range, or any age group within that age range.

Q: Can boys participate in the proposed programming?

A: While the emphasis should be on serving girls, programming that includes boys is permissible.

Q: Is subcontracting permissible?

A: Yes, as long as the proposal makes clear what activities the subcontractor will do, and that the subcontractor activity will be monitored effectively.

Q: Can an organization submit multiple proposals?

A: No, but the organization can include multiple programming components within the single proposal.

Q: Can an organization apply for both option 1 and option 2.

A: No, if an organization applies for option 2, it should include all programming components under option 2.
